**RESOLUTION NO. 2024-213
CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2024-22**

THE 2024 FRANCHISE ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN PEDRO, LAGUNA

Authored and Sponsored by: Coun. Vincent Jude T. Solidum

WHEREAS, it shall be the principle of the City Government of San Pedro, Laguna, to establish specific control and implementation of traffic management, policy and regulations in administering right traffic control and supervision to motorists as well as the pedestrians in order to attain smooth traffic flow which are inherent thereto;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991, which states among others, " xxx every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, o incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare." and Section 17(b)(4)(i) adequate communication and transportation facilities of a City; and as mandated by Republic Act No. 4136, otherwise known as "Land Transportation and Traffic Code of the Philippines", whereupon, considered as the mother code of all transportation and traffic system in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, urban road space is a scarce commodity, the competing use of which must be allocated for the greatest number through judicious, fair, participatory and informal traffic management system;

WHEREAS, regulation of TODA, the operation of motorized tricycles for hire and the issuance of franchise to operate such tricycles would pave the way to an enhanced tricycle transportation system in the city;

WHEREAS, it is necessary that additional provisions and amendments shall be made to some of the sections of the 2017 Traffic Ordinance of the City of San Pedro, Laguna to further improve the regulation of TODA, the operation of tricycles in the city and the issuance of tricycle franchises;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of San Pedro, Laguna in its regular session duly assembled, that:

ARTICLE I

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as "THE 2024 FRANCHISE ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN PEDRO, LAGUNA".

ARTICLE II

SECTION 2. SCOPE. This Ordinance shall apply to all Tricycles for Hire and private tricycles utilized for service purposes within the jurisdiction of the City of San Pedro, Laguna.

ARTICLE III

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. As used in this Ordinance the following terms are hereby defined as follows:

- a. **Board** – refers to the Public Utility Transportation Franchising Regulatory Board of the City of San Pedro.
- b. **Bicycle** – shall refer to any light straddle type personal vehicle.
- c. **Decibel (db)** – is defined as a unit expressing the relative intensity of sounds on a scale from zero (0) for the average least perceptible sound to about one hundred thirty (130) for the average pain level.
- d. **Decibel Meter** – an instrument to measure the levels of sound intensity.
- e. **Franchise** – is a privilege or power of a public concern which ought not to be exercised by a private individual at his will and pleasure but should be presumed for the public control or administration by the government directly or by public agents under such conditions and regulations as the government may impose in the public interest and for public security. It is a privilege where the individual cannot exercise as a right and which depends for its lawful existence upon a grant from the government.
- f. **Garage** – shall mean any building or space in which one or more vehicles, either with or without driver or operator are kept for safekeeping and /or storage.
- g. **Motorcycle** – shall refer to the two-wheeled motor vehicle attached or bolted to a wheeled side-car.

- h. **Motorized Tricycle Operator's Permit (MTOP)** – is the document granting a franchise or license to operate, issued to a person, natural or juridical allowing him to operate tricycle-for-hire over a particular zone specified therein.
- i. **Muffler** – is a gadget attached to the exhaust system of a gasoline/diesel fed engine of a motor vehicle or a tricycle to suppress excessive noise, as well as lessen smoke exhaust caused by combustion by the engine.
- j. **New or Reconditioned Motorcycle** – shall refer to a brand new two-wheeled motorcycle or a newly overhauled motorcycle and made into a good running condition and satisfactorily meets the requirements and functions as a public transport.
- k. **Old or Out-dated Motorcycle** – shall refer to the two-wheeled motorcycle attached or bolted to a wheeled side car, but which is already in a state of poor running performance and has outlived its effective usefulness as a public conveyance.
- l. **Pedicab** – two-wheeled vehicle with a steering handle, saddle, and pedal. The term shall include pedicabs and similar vehicles in so far as the same are pedaled.
- m. **Private Motorized Tricycle** – shall refer to a motorcycle with a wheeled side car unit bearing no body number and with a private plate utilized or operated for some personal or specific purpose other than a public utility within the City of San Pedro.
- n. **Public Utility Tricycle** – shall refer to a motorcycle/side car unit with granted franchise by the Public Utility Transportation Franchising Board of San Pedro, to operate and transport passengers within the City of San Pedro.
- o. **Reflectorized Stickers** – refers to any adhesive material, decal or metal object or device with a polished surface for reflecting light or provide illumination during nighttime.
- p. **Traffic Enforcer** – refers to designated member of the Public Order and Safety Office (POSO), Philippine National Police (PNP), Land Transportation Office (LTO), City of San Pedro Traffic Auxiliaries, and other public officers, who are deputized by the City Mayor for Traffic management and road safety enforcement.
- q. **Tricycle for Hire** – is a motor vehicle composed of a motorcycle fitted with a single-wheeled sidecar, or a motorcycle with a two-wheeled cab operated to render transport services to the general public upon demand for a fee.
- r. **Three-Wheeled Vehicles (TWVs)** – shall refer to three-wheeled vehicles which model/design may either be unibody, monocoque or non-conventional and which are popularly called Samosa, Tempo, Tuk-tuk, trishaw, Bajaj or Rickshaw in other Asian countries, such as India, Laos, Nepal, Thailand and Vietnam.
- s. **Zone** – is a contiguous land area or block, like a subdivision or a barangay where a tricycle-for-hire may operate without fixed origin and destination.

**ARTICLE IV
FRANCHISING AND POLICY MAKING BODY**

SECTION 4. CREATION OF PUBLIC UTILITY TRANSPORTATION FRANCHISING AND REGULATORY BOARD (PUTFRB) – The Public Utility Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (PUTFRB) is hereby created which shall serve as a policy-making body and supervise the franchising and/or regulation of the operation of public transport in the City of San Pedro, Laguna.

SECTION 5. POWERS, DUTIES, AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The Public Utility Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (PUTFRB) shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

1. Exercise direct control and supervision over all tricycle associations and cooperatives within the City. It shall have appellate jurisdiction over all decisions and orders of the Transportation Regulatory Unit involving intra and inter-association disputes. For this purpose, it can impose disciplinary measures against any association member or officer who refuses or fails to comply with its order.
2. Recommend and submit for review to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for appropriate legislative action of the following:
 - a. Amendment of Franchise for tricycle-for-hire;
 - b. Measures governing tricycle-for-hire such as, but not limited to, the issuance or cancellation of franchise/operating permits, fares, zones, city fees and other charges, and other traffic laws;
 - c. Measures affecting implementation of laws governing other public utility vehicles;
3. Coordinate with the LTO-DOTr regarding the franchising and compliance with the laws of public transport;
4. Review from time to time and amend, if necessary, the Implementing Rules and Regulations of this Ordinance and recommend the same to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for approval;
5. Conduct consultative meetings with the Barangays on transportation rules and policies;
6. Serve as the grievance committee concerning the issuance of Ordinance Violation Receipt (OVR).

SECTION 6. COMPOSITION. The Public Utility Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board shall be composed of the following:




**ARTICLE V
IMPLEMENTATION AND ENFORCEMENT**

SECTION 7. TRANSPORTATION REGULATORY UNIT. The Transportation Regulatory Unit of the City Government of San Pedro, Laguna shall be responsible for the implementation and enforcement of this Ordinance and shall have the following duties and functions:

- a. Oversee the standards of safety and good operating condition of public utility vehicles within the City of San Pedro, Laguna;
- b. Supervise the operation of all public utility tricycles, pedicabs, and Three-Wheeled Vehicles (TWVs) within the jurisdiction of the City of San Pedro;
- c. Conduct field inspection in areas of operation of public utility tricycles, TWVs, and pedicabs;
- d. Implement and enforce all laws, rules and regulations on the operation of public utility tricycles, TWVs, and pedicabs;
- e. Receive and process all franchising applications and submit to the PUTFRB for approval;
- f. Submit reports and other data needed by the PUTFRB, City Council, Office of the Mayor and other national and local government offices relevant to or which stands to affect public utility tricycle operation;
- g. Disseminate information regarding new laws, regulation, and ordinances relative to public utility tricycles, TWVs, and pedicab operations.

SECTION 8. In addition to its regular monthly reports, the Transportation Regulatory Unit (TRU) shall submit to the Mayor and to the Sangguniang Panlungsod reports on the status of operation and other pertinent matters relative to tricycle franchising.



ARTICLE VI
THREE-WHEELED VEHICLES (TWVs) CLASSIFICATION AND OPERATION

SECTION 9. CLASSIFICATION OF THREE-WHEELED VEHICLES. As defined in LTO Memorandum Circular No. 2020-2227, three-wheeled vehicles as well as quadricycles are classified as follows:

- A. PRIMARY CLASSIFICATION:
 - a. Motorcycle-Tricycle
 - b. Non-Conventional Motorcycle
- B. SUB-CLASSIFICATION/CATEGORIES:
 - a. Three-Wheeled Vehicle (L5)
 - b. Light Quadricycle (L6)
 - c. Heavy Quadricycle (L7)

SECTION 10. OPERATION OF L5, L6, AND L7 MOTO CYCLES. These types of vehicles are strictly prohibited along secondary national highways, **except** if there is no alternate route designated by the City Government, and they shall take the outermost lane or the right most portion of the road.

ARTICLE VII
GUIDELINES FOR FRANCHISING OPERATION
AND SUPERVISION OF TRICYCLE FOR HIRE

SECTION 11. APPLICATION AND FRANCHISE

- a. Only Filipino citizens or partnership or corporations with 60% Filipino Equity are qualified to apply for and become operators of tricycle-for-hire, provided they are in possession of valid registration papers of the units concerned from the Land Transportation Office (LTO).
- b. All applications shall be verified complete and accompanied by a common carrier's insurance certificate of cover, a sketch of the zone within which the applicant intends to operate.
- c. All existing franchise issued by the Public Utility Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (PUTFRB) shall remain valid only until the expiry date thereof. Any renewal and/or amendment thereto shall henceforth be governed by the provisions of this Ordinance.
- d. A grant of the Motorized Tricycle Operator's Permit (MTO) shall be limited to a single zone which the Tricycle Regulatory Unit may hereafter fix and delineate
- e. An applicant may apply for a MTO for more than one (1) unit, provided the designated zone of operation shall be within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of San Pedro.

- f. A Motorized Tricycle Operator's Permit (MTO) shall be valid only within the designated zone of operation and shall expire one (1) year after its issuance. Provided, however, that the applicant may opt to shorten its term amending, modifying or transferring the ownership of the unit involved upon proper application made for that purpose and will be limited to serve the unexpired portion of the validity. Transfer to another zone, change of ownership of unit or transfer of MTO shall be construed as an amendment to the existing MTO and shall require the appropriate endorsement of the Transportation Regulatory Unit for approval of the PUTFRB.
- g. The Public Utility Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (PUTFRB) shall be in-charge for the approval, issuance and renewal of the Motorized Tricycle Operator's Permit (MTO) or franchise to operate tricycle-for-hire.

SECTION 12. LIMITATIONS

- a. MTO shall be granted only to units operated by drivers with valid driver's license issued by the Land Transportation Office (LTO). The driver of motorized tricycle for hire shall carry with him at all times his driver's license and Franchise Identification Number to operate issued by the City.
- b. The MTO shall be deemed automatically cancelled if the operator or the driver thereof is convicted of major criminal offense that endangers public safety.
- c. Any violations of this Ordinance which the Sangguniang Panlungsod may determine to be sufficient cause for the cancellation of the MTO shall be made only after due process.
- d. For purposes of safety and convenience of passengers, tricycle for hire shall only be allowed to carry not more than three (3) passengers, that is two (2) passengers inside the sidecar and one (1) passenger at the back seat of the tricycle driver. The weights or volume of the tricycle load, including passengers should not exceed the maximum allowable capacity of the tricycle. Minors below thirteen (13) years old shall not be allowed to ride at the back seat of the tricycle driver.
- e. A common color for tricycles of each TODA shall be imposed. Each unit shall be assigned and bear an identification number aside from the LTO license plate number.
- f. A Tricycle-for Hire shall be allowed to operate on a Special service only within the designated zone specified in the MTO.
- g. Aside from the color coding per zone, the unit shall bear the registration sticker posted conspicuously therein.

SECTION 13. FRANCHISING REQUIREMENTS

A. ON TRICYCLES FOR HIRE



- e. Photocopy of Insurance Coverage for third party liability
- f. 2 x 2 I.D. picture (wearing TODA uniform)
- g. Photocopy of Professional Driver's License
- h. TODA Clearance
- i. TODA Uniform
- j. TODA Roof Color Coding
- k. Trash cans
- l. Roof number tagging






SECTION 14. SCHEDULE OF FEES

The following table of fees shall be collected from operators of motorized tricycles payable to the Office of the City Treasurer:

A. Public Motorized Tricycle/unit

SECTION 15. RENEWAL DATE. The Transportation Regulatory Unit (TRU) shall start to accept application for renewal of Franchise every January of each year. In case of late renewal of the same, a monthly surcharge of 25% on Franchise Fee shall be imposed, provided, however, that renewal of city sticker shall not be later than February 20 of every year.

SECTION 16. AUTOMATIC CANCELLATION OF PUBLIC MOTORIZED TRICYCLE FRANCHISE. The Motorized Operator's Permit (MTO)/Franchise shall be deemed automatically cancelled on the following grounds:

- a. If the operator failed to register with the Land Transportation Office (LTO) within thirty (30) days from the date the franchise was issued/granted;
- b. Motorized Tricycle Operator's Permit/Franchise issued to public motorized tricycle operator which had expired for more than three (3) months is deemed automatically cancelled (Municipal Ordinance No. 2000-05);
- c. If the operator or the driver thereof is convicted by final judgement of a crime against the Anti-Drug Law (R.A. 9165, otherwise known as the Comprehensive drug Law of 2002);
- d. Unauthorized transfer of franchise shall cause the immediate cancellation or revocation of the franchise;
- e. Unauthorized selling of franchise shall cause immediate cancellation or revocation of the franchise for the vendee and vendor.

SECTION 17. UNUSED/UNISSUED STICKERS. The association of the concerned TODA shall be liable for the unused/unissued City Stickers and shall shoulder the total amount of the unused/unissued stickers.

**ARTICLE VIII
RESTRICTIONS**

SECTION 20. PROHIBITION ON NATIONAL HIGHWAYS. All motorized tricycle, whether private or for hire are strictly prohibited in traversing along the National Highway, **except** when there is no alternative route designated by the City Government, Provided, they shall take the outermost lane or the right most portion of the road and strict enforcement of road safety and regulations is primarily observed.

SECTION 21. INTENSITY OF LOUDNESS. The intensity of loudness emanating from all tricycles operating within the City of San Pedro is regulated to a maximum of ninety (90) decibels.

SECTION 22. UNAUTHORIZED STICKERS. Unauthorized stickers and decals on front of windshields except official stickers by the Department of Transportation and authorized stickers issued by the City Government and other government agencies required to be displayed in front of the windshields.

SECTION 23. OLD AND OUTDATED MOTORCYCLES.

- a. The City Government of San Pedro authorizes and allows the change or replacement of old and outdated motorcycles for public utility tricycles operating within the jurisdiction of the City of San Pedro with new/reconditioned units. An Owner or operator of a public utility tricycle who intends to replace or change an old or outdated motorcycle with a new motorcycle unit shall file an application form for replacement or dropping of the old unit with the Transportation Regulatory Unit (TRU).
- b. A dropping fee of Two Hundred Pesos (Php 200.00) shall be charged against the applicant.
- c. The Tricycle Regulatory Unit shall conduct necessary inspection and verification and shall require as a pre-requisite a clearance for the replacement of the motorcycle to establish lawful ownership of the replacement vehicle.
- d. A public utility tricycle replaced with new or reconditioned motorcycle unit shall likewise be subject to inspection, testing, approval and documentation by the TRU with a report furnished to the PUTFRB for record purposes.

SECTION 24. LICENSE PLATES AND FRANCHISE NUMBER. Clean and visible license plates and franchise number are required on all vehicles plying within the City of San Pedro.

SECTION 25. ACCESSORIES REQUIRED OF A TRICYCLE.

- a. All motorized tricycles, whether private or for hire, are required to switch on their headlights and taillights while traversing streets within the City of San Pedro from 6:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. the following day;
- b. Adequate interior lighting is required to be installed in all tricycles for hire plying within the City of San Pedro. Luminous bulbs with not less than 21 Candle Power (CP) shall be installed inside. The use of dimly-lit colored lights are prohibited;

- c. Each sidecar shall be provided with an interior light fixture which shall be switched on between 6:00 in the evening until 6:00 in the morning or from sundown to sunrise the following day;
- d. All motorized tricycles operating within the jurisdiction of the City of San Pedro are required to have a silencer.

SECTION 26. GARBAGE RECEPTACLE. All public utility tricycles plying within the City of San Pedro, Laguna are required to install a garbage receptacle inside the tricycle.

SECTION 27. TODA IDENTIFICATION CARD. All TODA shall issue identification card to its members for identification purposes. Driver's Identification Card issued by the City Government and their respective TODA shall be displayed inside the tricycle.

SECTION 28. TODA UNIFORM. All drivers of tricycle-for-hire operating within the City of San Pedro are required to wear uniforms corresponding to the assigned color for their TODA. The make and style of uniform shall be prescribed by the Public Utility Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (PUTFRB) of the City of San Pedro. Wearing of slippers, sando and short pants are strictly prohibited.

**CHAPTER IX
TODA CLASSIFICATION**

SECTION 29. ZONE CODING AND COLOR SCHEME ASSIGNMENT. The following are the zone code and color scheme for all public utility tricycles operating within the jurisdiction of the City of San Pedro:

**CHAPTER X
MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS**

SECTION 30. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS. The Public Order and Safety Office-Traffic Management Unit (TMU) and Public Order and Safety Office-Transportation Regulatory Unit (TRU) through the assistance of the City Legal Office shall formulate the Implementing Rules and Regulations of this Ordinance.

SECTION 31. APPROPRIATION. The City Government of San Pedro, Laguna shall include in its budget and make necessary appropriations relative to the implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 32. INFORMATION DISSEMINATION. The Public affairs and Information Office (PAIO) shall disseminate this Ordinance to the public immediately upon its issuance. All Barangays within the City of San Pedro, Laguna are also directed to disseminate this Ordinance in its respective localities.


SECTION 33. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason, any provision or section of this Ordinance is declared not valid by a court of competent jurisdiction, suspended or revoked by other laws, such declaration, suspension or revocation shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions thereof, which shall continue to be in full force and effect.


SECTION 34. REPEALING CLAUSE. All City Ordinances, Rules and Regulations and/or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.
